

**Jill Sterrett**

Jill Sterrett has worked at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art since 1990 as Paper Conservator (1990-2000), Head of Conservation (2000-2002) and Director of Collections (2002-present). In her current role, she oversees the activities of six allied departments in a museum structure designed to put voices of living artists at the center of a collaborative approach to contemporary art stewardship and research. She has worked at the Fine Arts Museum of San Francisco, the Library of Congress, the Philadelphia Museum of Art, the National Library of Australia, and the National Gallery of Victoria. Jill is a graduate of Denison University with a B.A. in Chemistry and a B.A. in Art History. She earned her M.A. in Art Conservation from the Cooperstown Graduate Program. She has published and taught on the subject of museums, conservation and contemporary art, including as a Fulbright Scholar in Portugal. She has been the Board President of Voices of Contemporary Art since 2014.
