

Howard Besser

Howard Besser is Founding Director of NYU's Moving Image Archiving & Preservation (MIAP) MA program, where he has taught for the past 15 years. Previously he was a professor of Information Studies, and has been in charge of automation activities for two fine arts museums. Besser has been involved with both conservation and digital preservation since the 1990s, has taught classes and dozens of workshops on these subjects, and has published numerous articles on these. In 2009 he was named to Library of Congress's select list of "Pioneers of Digital Preservation". In addition to developing most of the MIAP curriculum, Besser has given all-day and multi-day workshops on media conservation and preservation to international audiences through both ICCROM's Safeguarding Sound and Image Collections (SOIMA), and through the International Federation of Library Associations (IFLA).
