Lena (Carol) Stringari is Deputy Director and Chief Conservator of the Guggenheim Museum and Foundation. Having joined the Guggenheim in 1992, she is responsible for developing policy and procedures for the care and treatment of the collection. Working closely with the conservation, curatorial and registration staff, she identifies priorities for collections care and oversees research and treatment. She manages conservation for a global loan and exhibition program, working with a team of conservators to assess risk and develop guidelines for safe travel, installation, and storage for the collection installation, and storage for the collection. In addition to numerous research projects and exhibitions, Ms. Stringari played a key role in formulating and implementing the Panza Collection Initiative as well as the Variable Media Initiative at the Guggenheim Museum. She is a founding member of the International Network for the Conservation of Contemporary Art (INCCA). She has lectured throughout the world on ethical considerations and the conservation of contemporary art.
