Mona Jimenez is the principal consultant for Materia Media, specializing in the conservation and preservation of independent media and media art. From 2003-2017 she was on the faculty of the Moving Image Archiving and Preservation Program at New York University and led curriculum development in areas of video preservation, collection management, and media art conservation. In 2018, she was a visiting scholar at the Getty Conservation Institute to develop a framework for surveying media art collections, and she recently served on the planning committee for “TechFocus III: Caring for Computer-based Art” and on curriculum committees for the IFA and MoMA. Jimenez is dedicated to participatory and cross-disciplinary models for media archiving and preservation practices; she founded NYU-MIAP’s international program Audiovisual Preservation Exchange (<https://tisch.nyu.edu/cinema-studies/miap/research-outreach/apex>) and initiated the Community Archiving Workshop model that brings together moving image experts and allies to help organizations and media makers inspect and inventory endangered AV collections (<https://amianet.org/events/community-archiving-workshop/>).
